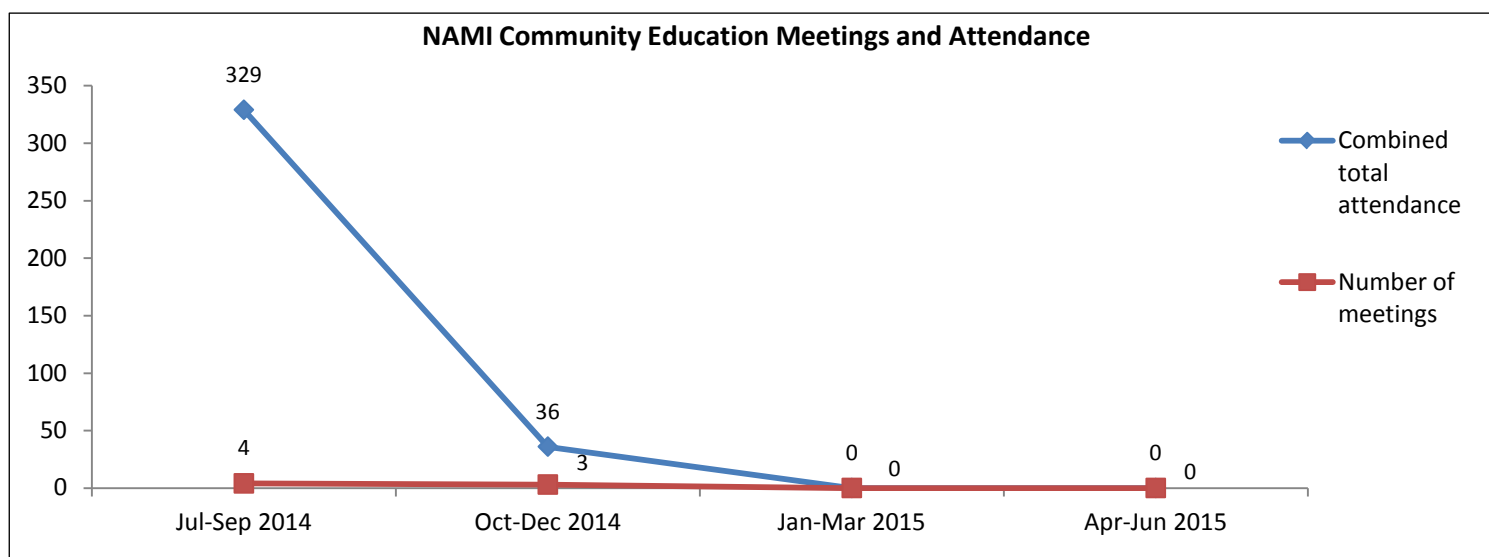


## NAMI Summary Report

July 2014 through June 2015

### Community Education

NAMI held 7 different 2-hour community education meetings in the most recent 12 months tracked. An average of 52 people attended each meeting. Because of some administrative and re-structuring issues in the local NAMI, there were no meetings reported for the Jan-Mar 2015 quarter, and only one meeting for the Apr-Jun 2015 quarter which was less than 2 hours in duration and so could not be included in this chart. However, a Community Outreach Coordinator has been appointed, and it is anticipated that meetings and attendance will increase in future quarters.



### Program Offerings

Neither the Peer-to-Peer Program nor the Basics Program was offered in the most recent 12 months tracked. However, additional trainers started classes in the most recent quarter; and, collaboration with other northern county NAMI chapters is being done, to help increase the availability of Peer-to-Peer, Family-to-Family and Basics classes locally.

The offering of a Family-to-Family class started in the July-September 2014 quarter, and completed in the October-December 2014 quarter. A total of 12 participants fully completed the Family-to-Family program in the most recent 12 months tracked.
